These processed donations are then transformed into thousands of individual gift packages that are ordered by local agencies for homeless and at-risk children in their care.

Requirements

- Time Commitment *
- Four, 3-hour shifts of volunteering at the mill.
- Eight, 3-hour shifts of managing and leading volunteer groups at the mill.
- One external collection drive (e.g. School, Church, Neighborhood, Community)
- Create a real change-proposal: find a way to improve the organization and present to management. Once approved, assemble a team and make it happen.
- Must complete and submit an SLC application. Applications may be found at giftstogive.org

*GiftsToGive is open six days a week. Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday, 9-5. Saturdays and Wednesdays, 9-3. All time commitment requirements must be completed by the end of the student's school-year.
